## For our riders in Ferndale

WTA is hosting a Paratransit Information Session in Ferndale. It will be at the Ferndale Public Library Conference Room on Friday, February 2, from 12 pm to 4:30 pm.

- Talk one-on-one with a WTA staff member regarding recent changes to paratransit
- Sign up for a Free on Fixed Route Card
- Sign up for a Regionial Reduced Fare Card

We will host Paratransit Information Sessions in other locations later in February.

## New "Pass-on-File"

Beginning March 1, 2018, WTA is changing how we collect fares from riders with bus passes. Instead of needing to show a physical bus pass to the driver, you can board with a Pass-on-File.

Here is how it will work:

- You can buy a Pass-on-File over the phone (at (360) 733-1144), or at Bellingham Station. A caregiver can also buy one for you.
- When you call to book a ride, the Customer Service Representative will know whether or not you have a valid Pass-on-File. If you don't, it can be purchased over the phone.
- Your driver will also know whether or not you have a valid Pass-on-File.
- If you do not have a Pass-on-File, you can pay cash (\$1), pay with a token, or show a WTA Gold Card. (Gold Cards allow riders 75 and older to ride FREE).
