## Changes to Will Calls are in effect

Thank you for your cooperation! On December 1, 2017, WTA made the following changes to the way we offer will calls:

- No will calls from your home address
- You must provide your pickup location when you book your will call
- No more than four will calls per day
- All trips after 7 pm must be booked as scheduled trips (not will calls)
- Will calls not activated by 7 pm will be canceled

## Ride WTA's Fixed Route Buses for Free

WTA's paratransit passes are no longer valid for fixed route buses.

If you sometimes ride fixed route buses, please get a "Free on Fixed Route" Card. Anyone who is eligible to ride WTA's paratransit can get a Free on Fixed Route Card.

Or, if you are over 75, you can get a Gold Card. With a Gold Card, you can ride WTA's fixed route buses AND paratransit buses for free.

To find out how to get your Free on Fixed Route Card or your Gold Card, call (360) 733-1144.

Another reminder: Personal Care Attendants (PCA's) can travel with you for free on both paratransit and fixed route buses. However, if you travel with a companion or friend, they'll need to pay the fare.
