- The maximum group size is $\mathbf{2 5}$, including students, teachers and chaperones. If your total group size is larger, you'll need to split into two or more groups and travel on different buses.
- We need your completed application at least 14 days before your trip.
- Classroom passes are non-transferable and are valid only for the date on the pass.
